ORDER

The Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for women, economically backward and physically handicapped meritorious students introduced by AICTE, as per guidelines read (1) was implemented in the University vide U O read(2) above.

Government vide G O read (3) above accorded sanction for 5% of additional intake for every sanctioned course approved by AICTE, Government and University concerned, in Government/Aided/Government controlled and Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges in the State for the year 2011-12 for implementing the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme introduced by the AICTE. In tune with the G O read (3) above and as per the orders of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, sanction has been accorded for 5% of additional intake for every sanctioned course approved by AICTE, Government and University concerned in the Government/Aided/Government controlled and Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges affiliated to this University for the academic year 2011-12.

The additional intake of 5% is sanctioned as per the conditions stipulated in the Guidelines of AICTE read as (1) above and Government Order read as (3), respectively and also subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All Colleges must implement the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme as per the conditions laid down by the AICTE in the guidelines dated 09.04.2007 and letter dated 16.04.2007.
- 2. The Colleges will publish the matter through the website and or otherwise invite applications for enrolment based on parameters fixed by AICTE.
- The Colleges will provide to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the complete details of students thus admitted and this information will also be put up on the website.

- 4. The Colleges shall furnish the details of admissions made under the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme to Government as well as the University also.
- 5. The Colleges will have to maintain a Register in this regard and to produce the same for inspection on demand by Government/University.
- 6. The Colleges must furnish compliance report to Government and University by stating the details of students who were the beneficiaries of the scheme.

Orders are issued accordingly.
