The previous semesters (S1 and S2) were conducted online due to the covid situation. A total of 28 students participated in the program, out of 41 students from the class (MEA, 2020-24 Batch).

Introductory Session (08:30 AM – 10:45 AM)

Dr. Jibin T Philip (Class Teacher, MEA, 2020-24 Batch) welcomed the dignitaries and the gathering. He briefed about the importance of campus life and seeking excellence in academics. He also introduced the other speakers of the program.

Dr. Ajithkumar J P, HIC, Dept of MEA talked about the essentiality of following the code and conduct inside the college campus. He stressed more about the advanced labs and certification programs (internships) offered by the institute (AJCE). The students have been urged to take up these opportunities (positively) to improve their respective profiles.

Prof. Sherin Sam Jose, Head of Department, Department of Mechanical Engineering Automobile, Amal Jyothi College of Engineering, gave the keynote address to the students. His speech was inclined more towards the need for imbibing ideas/knowledge and being organized in achieving goals. He included a large number of real-life examples to prove his point and which in turn helped to keep the attention of the students. Besides, the students were motivated to take up leadership roles to remain involved in product development, research, and start-up activities.

Interactive Sessions (11 AM – 3:30 PM)

Session 1 (11:00 AM – 01:00 PM)

The students were provided with the opportunity to interact with selected final year students (Jubin Thaj, Onesimos K K, Adarsh Shivaprasad) to gain insight into the experiences (inside and outside the campus) and need for taking up responsibilities. The students were allowed to freely interact with the seniors to share their concerns and doubts (as a student) regarding campus life.



Session 2 (02:00 AM – 03:30 PM)

Sebastian James, AJCE Alumnus (AUE, 2012-16 Batch) and Junior Assistant (JA), Kerala State Financial Enterprises (KSFE) interacted with the students regarding his experience in AJCE. His emphasis of the talk was on the importance of selecting an appropriate career path to succeed in life. He shared his thoughts on opting for a financial stream as his work domain. The students were elated to be exposed to real-life knowledge.
